The Summer School “**Analytics on European current affairs**” (**An.EU.Affair**) is part of the JMCoE’s “*VisuALEU Academy*” activity.

Scope

The Summer School is an annual, international event focusing on **(a) EU Policy Analysis** and **(b) EU Social & Foreign Affairs**.

The school is a high value learning, yet enjoyable experience. More specifically:

The Policy Analysis strand is skills-oriented, ICT based workshop-style course that focusing on the EU and particularly on contextual and decisional policy analysis for the most part focusing on skills development using sophisticated yet intuitive software tools with .

The Social and Foreign Affairs strand is a bird’s eye view of EU insights focusing on integration, global policy, social policies, values, local government, and multiculturalism.

Learning outcomes

The **Policy Analysis strand** is multidisciplinary at heart, fusing (a) policy content analysis and (b) the use of analytics software and techniques to analyze policies with Eurostat data. Participants will have the opportunity to apply the newly acquired skills in the form of a capstone project.

The **Social and Foreign affairs strand** serves as a unique insight into European integration along with insights in EU’s global policies, touching on security and strategy, social policies, local policies and governance, issues of trust and multicultural diversity.
